

IRON COUNTY, MI - PARKS

Bewabic State Park

Located on the north and west shores of Fortune Lake, right off US 2. Activities include swimming, boating, fishing, tennis. There is a daily/seasonal fee.

Pentoga Park

A county park on the south shore of Chicaugon lake. The entrance is off County Road 424, about halfway between Gaastra and Alpha. A large grassy area, playground equipment, beach, campground and Indian burial grounds. There is a daily/ seasonal fee.

Gibson Lake Park

2 miles south of Amasa and just west of US 141. Camping, pavilion, change house, playground equipment, swimming.

Holmes Park

Stambaugh Twp run, located on Little Smoky Lake in the far southwest corner of Iron County. Along Forest Highway 16, about a mile north of the Wisconsin border. A small (7 unit) campground with no electricity or water but there is a boat landing, beach, and change house. There is a daily fee.

Holmes Lake Park

11 miles east of Crystal Falls then North on County Line Road. A small (4 unit) campground with swimming and fishing.

Ice Lake Park

A city park on the west shore of Ice Lake, south of US 2 and just north of the hospital. It has a sandy beach, some playground equipment and a change house.

Bachman Park

A city park at the corner of Franklin St and Third Ave, with a playground, softball diamond and tennis and basketball courts.

Nanaimo Park

An Iron River city park on Third Ave just north of the river, with picnic tables and a pavilion.

Runkle Lake Park

A city park on the west shore, north of M-69 and a few blocks east of the Paint River. A Campground (57 units), baseball diamonds, tennis courts, several buildings and sandy beach.

Bates Township Park - Sunset Lake

In Bates Twp with a beach, playground, boat launch, baseball diamonds, picnic area and campground (13 units).

Dawson Lake Park

On the far eastern end of Iron County, operated by Mansfield Twp. Just south of M-69, on Dawson Lake Road.

Glidden Lake

South of M-69, just west of Lake Mary Road

Stager Lake

About 1 ½ miles west of US 2-141 on Stager Lake Road

Nelson Field

On Evergreen St just east of Washington Ave with tennis courts, basketball court, picnic tables, playground and a walking track around the football field.
