

# Iron County, MI Parks

## **Bachman Park**

A city of Iron River park at the corner of Franklin St and Third Ave with a playground, softball diamond, tennis courts, and basketball courts.

## **Bates Township Park – Sunset Lake**

In Bates Twp with a beach, playground, basketball court, boat launch, pavilion, picnic area, and campground.

## **Bewabic State Park**

Located on the shores of Fortune Lake, right off US 2. This state park amenities include swimming, boat launch, fishing, tennis courts, and beach volleyball.

There is a daily/seasonal fee.

## **Buck Lake Park**

36-acre park located off County Road 424 in Mastodon Township. Includes a mile long nature trail along the lakeshore, pavilion, picnic tables, fishing pier, boat launch, and pit toilet.

## **Caspian Community Park**

A revamped park in 2025, this park offers a basketball court, tennis court, pickleball court, playground, and a pavilion.

## **Dawson Lake Park**

On the Eastern end of Iron County operated by Mansfield Twp. Amenities include a campground, pavilion, dock, and playground.

## **Gaastra City Park**

A city owned park that offers a playground and basketball court.

## **Gibson Lake Park**

Near Amasa, this park has camping, a pavilion, change house, bathrooms, playground, basketball court, and swimming.

## **Glidden Lake**

South of M-69, just west off Lake Mary Road offers camping, swimming, fishing, boat launch, hiking trails, and a toilet. A state park pass is required.

## **Holmes Lake Park**

11 miles east of Crystal Falls then North of County Line Road in Mastodon Township. Offers a small campground with swimming and fishing.

## **Holmes Park**

A small park and campground on Little Smokey Lake in Stambaugh Twp.

## **Ice Lake Park**

A city of Iron River park on the west shore of Ice Lake. Includes a sandy beach, playground, bathrooms, and a change house.

# Iron County, MI Parks

## Joe Mechon Park

Located in downtown Amasa, this park offers a playground, picnic area, pavilion, basketball court, and fishing pier.

## Lincoln Park

Located at the bottom of the hill in Crystal Falls, this park offers a playground, picnic area, and bathroom. This park connects to the Paint River boardwalk next to the park that goes along the Paint River.

## Nanaimo Park

A city of Iron River owned park next to the Iron River on Third Ave, it has a pavilion with picnic tables, bathrooms, and playground.

## Nelson Field

On Evergreen St in the City of Iron River, this park has tennis courts, pickleball courts, basketball courts, picnic tables, playground, bathrooms, and a walking track.

## Pentoga Park

A county park off County Road 424 with a large grassy area, playground, change house, beach, pavilion, campground, Indian burial grounds, and a general store.

## Runkle Lake Park

A city of Crystal Falls park right off Hwy M-69. Includes a campground, baseball diamond, basketball court, tennis court, soccer field, playground, swimming, beach, and pavilion.

## Stager Lake

A small park on Stager Lake Road in Mastodon Township. It features picnic tables, a playground, fishing pier, swimming area, boat launch, change house, and toilets.

## Veterans Park

Located next to the power dam in Crystal Falls, it offers picnic tables, fishing area, boat launch, and pit toilets.
